June 19, 1905 (Caldonia, IL) February 15, 1992 (Rockford, IL)



Fred Carl Sally, 86, Rockford, died in his home at 1:30 a.m. Saturday, February 15, 1992. The son of Fred and Agnes (Hacker) Sally, he was born June 19, 1905, in Caldonia, but lived most of his life in Rockford, IL. United States Census records note that he completed his first year of high school, but the fact that Russell earned his General Education Diploma (GED) is listed on the 1961 Commencement Program of West High School, Rockford, IL. He married Irene L. Stenander in Rockford on June 29, 1927; she died December 3, 1988. Fred enlisted in the United States Army and served in World War II. Before and after his military service he worked as a mechanic and in various other jobs in the automotive industry; he likely he retired from his job as Inspector at J.I. Case.

Survivors include son, Richard C. (Geraldine) Sally (Rockford); daughter, Lois Elizabeth Sally (New York); grandsons, Jeffrey (Houston, TX) and Joel (Rockford); brothers, Walter Sally (Colorado Springs, CO) and Irvin Sally (Phoenix, AZ); and many nieces and nephews. In addition to his parents and wife, Fred was predeceased by his brother, Howard; and sisters, Elsie and Edna.

Graveside services were held at 11:00 a.m. February 19th in Rockford's Greenwood Cemetery officiated by Reverend Dr. Dale W. Hallberg, Pastor of Trinity Lutheran Church. Arrangements were entrusted to Rockford's Anderson-Long-Klontz Funeral Home on Court Street at Park Avenue. There was no visitation. In lieu of flowers, mourners are encouraged to make memorials to a charity of choice.
