

He graduated from West Rockford High in 1961 where he participated in many school activities and varsity athletics. He graduated from the University of Illinois in 1965 with a Bachelor of Science degree, again active in many campus activities and organizations particularly, Phi Delta Theta social fraternity which he dearly loved. John received his Master of Education degree from Boston University in 1994. John was a career Army officer retiring as a Colonel in 1992. He entered active duty in 1966 with his first assignment being Sinop, Turkey. From there, he was assigned to Ft. Campbell, KY; Camp Vayama, Thailand; Ft. Drum, NY; and then on to the Republic of Vietnam -Advisory Team 96, IV Corps, Military Assistance Command (MACV) in the Mekong Delta. Upon returning from Vietnam, John was sent to Europe -Heidelberg, Germany. His next assignment after Europe was Ft. Lewis, Washington followed by advisory duty to the US Army Reserves and National Guard units of Alabama, Tennessee, and Mississippi, headquartered out of Redstone Arsenal, (Huntsville) Alabama. Next, John was sent to the Pentagon in Washington, DC where he was the Chief of Enlisted Recruiting for the entire US Army, working out of the Office of the Deputy Chief of Staff for Personnel. From the Pentagon, he went on to Headquarters, United States Special Operations Command in Tampa, FL

where he was a member of the Special Staff. Following that, he was sent to New England where he became the Chief of Staff of Fort Devens, MA. His final assignment was as the Director of Personnel for the US Army Test and Evaluation Command headquartered out of Aberdeen Proving Ground, MD. He and his family moved to Niceville in 1992.

Col Andrle's military awards and decorations include: the Legion of Merit (1 OCL - Oak Leaf Cluster), Bronze Star Medal (1 OLC), Defense Meritorious Service Medal, the Meritorious Service Medal, Army Commendation Medal (2 OLC), Joint Meritorious Service Award, National Defense Service Medal, Vietnam Service Medal, Army Service Ribbon, Overseas Service Ribbon, Vietnam Campaign Medal, Republic of Vietnam Gallantry Cross Unit Citation, Parachutist Badge, and Army General Staff Badge.
